ArtRage for iOS v2.2

Before we begin

- Close all 'Parked' Applications: If you are using iOS 5 or above, other applications may be open in the background and some may be using memory or processor resources. To close them, double tap the Home button on your iPad. This brings up a list of all open applications. Swipe up to close them.
- If you find that the ArtRage is laggy close all apps and re start your iPad.

If you have not already imported the apple into your photo album take a photo of it with your iPad's camera now.







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Intro to Menus, Tools Colours & Multi Touch Gestures

Bottom Menu

BRUSH SIZE: If you tap the number, your keyboard will appear & you can enter the brush size. You can also long press this button and slide up. With your finger still on the screen you will see a grey arc. Without lifting your finger slide it back and forth on that arc and you can change the tool size without the keyboard. **Note:** If you don't want to do either of these to change the tool size, use the multi touch gesture for changing tool size (Three finger slide up and down on the canvas).

SETTINGS: Tap the settings icon to open the Settings panel to adjust individual tool settings, like pressure, thinners, opacity, smoothing & size. Note each tool will have different sliders and adjustments. You might also see above the sliders written No Preset Loaded. Tap that to see the variations of that tool. To reset the airbrush to its default tap the cog on the top right and press reset tool.

UNDO: Tap the undo icon to undo the last brush stoke and action you did. There are unlimited undoes in ArtRage as long as you have that painting open. Note: The multi gesture touch for undo is a 3 finger swipe left. **REDO:** Tap the redo icon to redo the last undoes you have done. Note: The multi gesture touch for redo is a 3 finger swipe right.

MAIN MENU: Tap the main menu icon to access the menu here, including the gallery, preferences, stylus options and help files.

LAYERS: Tap the layers icon to access your layers, and all the features available (importing, blend modes and more). We will get to this later.

REFERENCES: Tap the references icon to add reference photos and images & tracing images to the canvas. If this is the first time you tap this icon it might ask you to access your photo library. Select allow to access photo library.

SAMPLES: Tap this icon to store, organise and recall colours you want to work with in the future.

MOVE SAMPLES: Tap this icon when you like a colour and want to quickly move it to samples. TS

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Tool Pod & Picker

Fill Tool: Fills bordered areas on your canvas. Tap in an area and it will be filled with the current colour.

Colour Sampler: Samples colour from the canvas. Tap and drag on the canvas and the colour beneath the sampler will be selected as the current colour.

Eraser: Erases all kinds of media from the canvas. If there's thick paint, thins the paint before removing it.

Glitter Tube: Sprinkles particles of glitter on the canvas with optional shapes for texturing.

Gloop Pen: Creates a smooth flow of ink that spreads on the canvas. Tap and hold to start the flow. The slower you drag, the more ink is spread on the canvas.

Pastel: Places dry strokes of wax or chalk on the canvas that can be smudged and break up easily on canvas grain.

Felt Pen: Simulates markers and highlighters with bold, colourful strokes.

Inking Pen: Fine line inking pen for detail work. Turn up 'Smoothing' and the lines auto-smooth when your stroke ends.

Pencil: Fine pencil strokes with a adjustable softness for shading, and a high precision technical pencil.

Paint Tube: Lays down thick lines of paint that can be smeared and blended with the palette knife or other tools.

Roller: Places broad strokes of evenly applied paint. The higher the Pressure, the more the paint breaks up on the canvas as the roller picks it up as it passes.

Palette Knife: A variety of blenders for smearing, smudging, and blending paint on the canvas.

Airbrush: A fine mist sprayer that applies colour without flattening or spreading the texture of paint already on the canvas.

Watercolour: Paints delicate strokes of wet pigment that blend with other paint and react to paper wetness.

Oil Brush: Applies strokes of oil with varying thickness. Paint on the brush runs down over time but you can keep applying the stroke to pick up other pigment and blend it on the canvas.

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Active Tool

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Colour Pod & Picker

- Your colour pod is on the lower right of your screen.
- Tap on the pod to see all your colours.
- With a single finger tap, hold and drag in the luminance portion and see the different shades of the colour you have chosen.
- Tap and hold in the hue arc and change hue but not the luminance. Note: The hue arc looks like a rainbow.
- If you want to quickly sample a colour you have already painted, long press on the canvas with one finger and drag the colour picker over the colour you want to choose.
- Metal arc makes a high sheen on your paint and high texture on your pastel.

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Multi touch gestures

One Finger:

Tap and drag with one finger to paint on the canvas. If you're using oils, try smearing them together to blend colors!

Two Fingers:

Tap and drag two fingers to manipulate the canvas:


Tip: A single tap on the canvas with two fingers will reset it to normal size and position.

Tip: Want to rotate the canvas? Rotate your iPad!

Three Fingers:

Tap and drag with three fingers for quick access to important functions.

Tip: A single tap on the canvas with three fingers will show or hide the toolbar.





Painting an Apple Tutorial Using Layers and Layer Effects

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1) Tap the ArtRage icon on the menu bar.



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2) Tap on the option Create New Painting.

3) If there is a prompt to save your work tap on it to save.

4) Tap on Name: and rename to Apple Tutorial

5) Tap on Record Script file for future playback.

6) Select Paper texture Watercolour.

7) Chantge Scale to 59% & Depth to 30%


8) Change your page colour to a light cream. (If you wish)



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Layers

10) Press layer icon on
bottom menu bar.
12) Press + for a new layer.
13) Press the + five times to
have 5 layers.



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Note:

Active layers are **highlighted**. Layers are also thumbnails so as you draw your marks will show up on the layer that is active.

The Checkered part of the layers means that it is transparent.

Eye icon turns layer visibility on and off.


Arrow icon **On Layer** changes Layer: Opacity, Lock Transparency or (MASK), Blend, Clear, Delete, Merge Down, Transform (Resize, Flip or Rotate), Copy to Clipboard, Duplicate Layer & Export.

Blend options changes how selected layer will react with layers underneath it.

Move Layer by long pressing the selected layer. **Drag** the 3 bars on the right of the layer. Then tap **Done**.

Arrow icon Above Layers lets you: Add layer, Import Layer (Photo), Paste a layer to another iPad app, Merge all layers & Change Canvas Settings.

Tip: Pallet Layer: A good way to make a pallet is to select a layer and designate it as your pallet layer where you can mix and blend your colours. When you have finished drawing you can always delete it or hide it for your final export.




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
Note:


- With 2 fingers on the reference image you can increase or decrease its size or change its angle.
- To select colours from the reference image tap on the reference image. You will see a change in the colour pallet.

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

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
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

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25) Tap Pencil Icon on toolbar.26) Long press the pencil tosee the pencil presets.




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- If you have a really shaky hand you can choose Heavy and Smooth.
- If your line is too dark you can change the layer opacity to 50%.
- Triple tap screen to hide menu bar & tap each pod to hide them.
- 3 finger slide up and down on screen to change tool size.

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
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


Note:

- If you make a mistake 3 finger swipe left.
- If you need an eraser select the eraser tool
- To draw details zoom in with a 2 finger pull.
- 2 finger tap will return you to 100 % Zoom.


- Select a colour from your colour pod lower right. Or
- Select colours from the reference image tap on the reference image. You will see a change in the colour pallet. Or
- Long press on the screen and slide your finger around to select a colour.

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36) Tap Pallet Icon. 37) Long tap icon to see brush presets. 38) Select Hard out Smudge or Hard Wet Blender or Just Blend Color.

Note:

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 To add more paint texture, select paint tube and add dots and lines of paint.

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Select Pallet tool and smudge them around.

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 If you see this icon pop up, tap it to save your progress.

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
