



- Third layer will be for our paint.
- Fourth layer will be for our shadows or background.

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
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
# Creating a Mask Layer


(You only want to paint a part of the image)

10) Start painting the side of the barn red

## Note:

- If you want to save this brush, call it Mask Brush.
- Zooming in will make it easier to paint the detail.
- Three finger slide will change your brush size

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

15) Pick the eraser tool.
16) Tap on brush settings on menu bar
17) Change eraser settings to 100% size
18) Pressure 100%
19) Softness 0%
20) Erase all of the red you have just drawn away.

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21) Pick any Brush and start painting
in. You will notice that it paints in only
the area that is locked.
22) Paint with lots of colours.
23) Change the Layer Blend Mode to
Multiply or Watercolor.
24) Change the Opacity to suite.


